## **Parent Tax Filers Verification (V1)**

Your Student's 2017–2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we must ask you to confirm the information you reported on the FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this institutional verification document and with any other required documents. If there are differences, the FAFSA information may need to be corrected. A parent whose information was reported on the FAFSA must complete and sign this institutional verification document, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to us. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact us as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

**Important Note:** The instructions below apply to each parent included in the household. Notify the financial aid office if the parents filed separate IRS income tax returns for 2015 or had a change in marital status after the end of the 2015 tax year on December 31, 2015.

**Tax Information:** Complete this section if the parents <u>filed or will file</u> a 2015 IRS income tax return(s). The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) that is part of FAFSA on the Web at <u>FAFSA.gov</u>. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2015 income information that was transferred into the student's FAFSA using the IRS DRT if that information was not changed.

## The parents have used the IRS DRT in FAFSA on the Web to transfer 2015 IRS income tax return information into the student's FAFSA. The verification process will not be able to be completed until the financial aid office receives the updated FAFSA. The parents are unable or choose not to use the IRS DRT in FAFSA on the Web, and instead will provide the school a 2015 IRS Tax Return Transcript(s). The verification process will not be able to be completed until the financial aid office receives the tax transcript. To obtain a 2015 IRS Tax Return Transcript, go to www.IRS.gov and click on the "Order a Return or Account Transcript" link. Make sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript" and not the "IRS Tax Account Transcript." Use the Social Security Number (or the IRS individual taxpayer number) and the date of birth of the first person listed on the 2015 IRS income tax return, and the address on file with the IRS (normally this will be the address used on the 2015 IRS income tax return. If you prefer, you may submit a paper request IRS Form 4506-T. If the parents filed separate 2015 IRS income tax returns, 2015 IRS Tax Return **Transcripts** must be provided for both. Check here if a **2015 IRS Tax Return Transcript(s)** is provided.
